INDEX TO NATURALIZATION PETITIONS AND RECORDS OF THE U.S. DISTRICT  
COURT, 1906-1966, AND THE U.S. CIRCUIT COURT, 1906-1911,  
FOR THE DISTRICT OF MASSACHUSETTS

On this microfilm publication is reproduced the name indexes to the petitions and records of naturalization of the U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts, 1906 to 1966, and the U.S. Circuit Court for the District of Massachusetts, 1906 to 1911. These records have been assigned to records of the United States District Courts (Record Group 21), and are in the custody of the National Archives-New England Region located in Waltham, MA.

The records filmed here are two separate indexes prepared by the United States District court. One index, includes the years 1906 to 1926; the other, the years 1927 to 1966. The earliest petitions indexed by these records were filed on September 27, 1906; the latest petitions are for those people naturalized through Dec 31, 1966. The index for the period 1906 to 1926 consists of 3x5 inch card forms, arranged alphabetically by the surname of the petitioner. Each card shows the petitioner's name, address, date and place of birth, occupation, spouse's name, petition and certification numbers, and date of admission. The index includes references to petitions filed in the U.S. District Court from 1906 to 1926 and in the U.S. Circuit Court from 1906 until Dec. 31, 1911, when the U.S. Circuit Courts were abolished. Among the petitions indexed are those by persons in the military service of the United States. The latter are called "military petitions."

The index for the years 1927 to 1966 consists of 3x5 inch stubs from certificates of naturalization issued by the clerk of court. The stubs are arranged alphabetically by the surname of the petitioner. Information recorded on the stubs varies over the 40-year period but all contain the petitioner's name and address, age or date of birth, petitions and certificate numbers, date of admission to citizenship, the date the certificate was issued, and the petitioner's signature. Some stubs contain the declaration of intention number, the alien registration number, the petitioner's name change, if any, and the names of the petitioner's spouse and children. "Military petitions" are among the records indexed in this file.

The naturalization petitions and records indexed by the two series filmed in this publication are also held by the National Archives-New England Region. Some of them are included on National Archives microfilm publication M1368, *Petitions and Records of Naturalization of the U.S. District Court and the U.S. Circuit Court for the District of Massachusetts, 1906 to 1929.*

The National Archives-New England Region also has book indexes to these naturalization petitions for the period 1906 to 1942.
